Old Business

Fundraising Update:

- We are starting the Bacon Fundraiser on Monday September 14. Each box has 11lbs of fresh cut bacon, regular for \$70 per box or thick cut for \$75 per box and the school receives \$15 per box sold. Teresa will be going to the school to talk to each classroom about the fundraiser and our school goal will be to raise \$2000.00. Pick up date will tentatively be Wednesday October 7, 2020.
- We are looking into a fundraiser specifically for the junior high students; selling Nutrient Ice Melt to fundraise for their sports activities.
- We are also still looking into doing some movie nights and the Little Caesars Pizza Fundraiser in the new year.

New Business

Society Facebook Page:

- Tara McQueen would like to start a Fort Assiniboine Parents Society Facebook page and Teresa Dekker let everyone know there is a Facebook page already for the Fort Assiniboine School Parent Council and Parent Society. We would just like to get the word out on everything Parent Society so we will be using the Facebook page for all Parent Society information.

- Lorna Hiemstra said the first few weeks of school have been a huge learning curve for

 families that have decided to homeschool their children however our attendance numbers
 have stayed steady with our large kindergarten class again this year and 3 new students in
 other grades.
- There will be no school field trips for the foreseeable future.
- Lorna Hiemstra is looking into school sports. She currently has 7 girls interested in volleyball, currently they can play games against one other school. The school can only do one sport at a time, so the students are only in one cohort at a time. She is looking into getting parents to drive for games.
- The students seem very happy to be back at school, even with the mask wearing for the older students.
- Lorna Hiemstra will talk with the students and the Students Union about a wish list of items
 they would like to get from the fundraising we will be doing this year. A nice way to get the
 students involved.
