#### Kindergarten - Thursday October 27

Will dress-up in our costumes on the 27th (IN THE AFTERNOON) and then tour the other classes in the school to show them off.

Please do not send your child to school in the morning in their costume and we ask that you make the costume simple enough for the child to get into with minimal help.

#### Grade 1-9 - Monday October 31

Will dress-up in our costumes on the 31th (IN THE AFTERNOON) Followed by Classroom activities (watch for more info in student agendas) We will do a costume parade at the end of the day, around 3:30. Parents are welcome to watch and we would greatly appreciate you taking home your child's pumpkin.

We have a policy at the school where no weapons or replicas (guns, swords, etc.) of any kind are permitted. Please keep this in mind when planning a costume for our Halloween dress-up.

MEDICATION: We can not administer medications such as Calamine lotion, Polysporin, Afterbite, anything with any kind of medicine in it. If a student requires to take any kind of medicine (prescription or over the counter) in to take during the day, the medication must be brought in by a parent to the school office. Medication should be in it's original packaging. Consent forms must be completed, medication will be kept and dispensed as directed under supervision in the office.

For those students with Epipen, puffers Twinject etc. please inform office and teacher, bring those items to the office to make arrangement for safe storage.

#### <u>Important Message for</u> **Everyone who Stops in at the** School

The MAIN DOORS into the school will be locked throughout the day. Please knock on the door, the window or call the school at 584-3751 and someone will be with you shortly.

We would like to ask **ALL** visitors to the school to check in and out of the building at the office. This includes dropping off lunches, or picking up your child early from school. Please **DO NOT** use the Library as an entrance into the school. This request is for the safety of the <u>children</u>, the <u>school staff</u>, as well as yours. For example, if we have a fire drill or lockdown we need to know who is in the building.

# PHSD Board News

Happy October!

In May 2022, the Alberta Government reached a settlement with the Alberta Teachers Association that included a cost of living increase. The Board passed a motion that Appendix 1 of the Non-Union Staff salary grids is to include a 1.75% increase in pay rates effective September 1, 2022 and a further increase of 2% effective September 2023.

With the continued difficulty in the recruitment and retention of qualified school bus drivers, Chair Lefebvre will submit a written request to the provincial government for PHSD to implement a retention allowance for union and non-union PHSD bus drivers. The allowance will be in addition to the 2022-23 approved compensation rates for the bus driver classification. We will also be requesting the timeline for implementation of wage increases be moved up to September 2022 (from June 2023).

The Board approved, in principle, the international trips for Barrhead Composite High School senior students to travel to Italy/Greece and photography students to London in 2023.

Assistant Secretary-Treasurer Veronica Lindquist presented the Internal Audit Accountability Report with the results showing that the practices and procedures in all division schools are achieving a high level of acceptability.

The Board met with representatives from the Public School Boards Association at our September 28 meeting to discuss a membership in the association.

On behalf of the Board, Trustee Melissa Hanna, presented a long service award of 10 years to Ms. Jolene Lefebvre. Thank you Ms.Lefebvre for your hard work and dedication to the children.



Please submit the form (for each child) by September 17th.
