Literacy Update

Pembina Hills teachers have had extensive professional development in literacy this year, specifically in the development of rubrics for student writing analysis. All grade 1-6 students have participated in daily writing and in division wide writing prompts to promote and develop writing fluency. Our Fort students have shown fantastic growth in writing creativity and stamina. We continue to teach/learn writing conventions, spelling, grammar, and other structural pieces, alongside creative brainstorming, storyboard planning, and using "juicy" descriptive words. There is a direct correlation to improvements in reading through writing and accountable talk (intentional topics to promote student interest and focussed engagement).





Steven Montgomery from Barrhead Composite High School came in to tell us about their International trip to Europe for Grades 10-12. It looked like they had a great time.

Trustee Sherry Allen went over a few changes to policies P-08 committees of the board and P-09 Protocol for Trustee Dignitary Recognition.

At the last PSBAA meeting on April 13, 2023, it was proposed and accepted to increase fees due the cost of inflation, and rising cost of presenters. PSBAA has not had an increase in fees for about 4 years.

The government has made changes to the transportation funding. Keep a look out for more information.

Superintendent Borgfjord presented the division's annual satisfaction survey results. Overall, the survey shows that there has not been a significant change over the past few years. This year, we had more parents complete the survey.

Superintendent Borgfjord also reported on the RAP and dual credit courses. 
On May 10, 2023 the trustees will be going to visit the two Colony schools and Pembina North Community School.




Join us to celebrate 200 years of history at one of the oldest fur trading posts in Alberta.
